### 2.0 Important Notes

#### 2.1 \*Provisional Results

- 2.1.1 Provisional results are results which have been approved by the University Examination Board but have not receive the endorsement from UniKL Senate.

- 2.1.2 The results can be referred to for internal purposes only for example, to carry out registrations for semester and courses, appeals against grades and to register for re-sit examinations (if any)
- 2.1.3 The provisional results released to students will allow students to view
  - (i) the 'Passed' or 'Failed' status for courses that they have been assessed this semester,
  - (ii) their CGPA
- 2.2 Endorsed results are final examination results which have been endorsed by Senate. The results released after the Senate's endorsement are official graded results which a student can view on his student portal.
- 2.3 #Re-sit of Failed course(s)
  - 2.2.1 Re-sit is available only for courses with final examinations.
  - 2.2.2 Re-sit is allowed for a failed course or courses if a student is eligible to re-sit the course(s).
  - 2.2.3 Eligibility will depend on the percentage that the student had attained in his coursework
  - 2.2.4 If a student is eligible to re-sit, he will be informed individually via UniKL mobile apps and the course(s) that are eligible for re-sit will be tagged as "Eligible to Re-sit", when the student views his result at the Student's Portal.
  - 2.2.5 Re-sit will be conducted between Week 0 to Week 2 of the July semester 2019.
    - 2.2.5.1 The dates in Table 1 above, have been chosen by campus based on operational factors contributed by students and staff and thus may differ from one campus to another.
